

How can I get tested?

If you think you may be sick, contact your healthcare provider. You will be advised on next steps and they may recommend a COVID-19 test for you.



Your provider will either perform the test at their office or they may refer you to a testing site.



The COVID-19 testing process involves swabbing the inside of your nose with a long Q-tip for about 10-15 seconds.

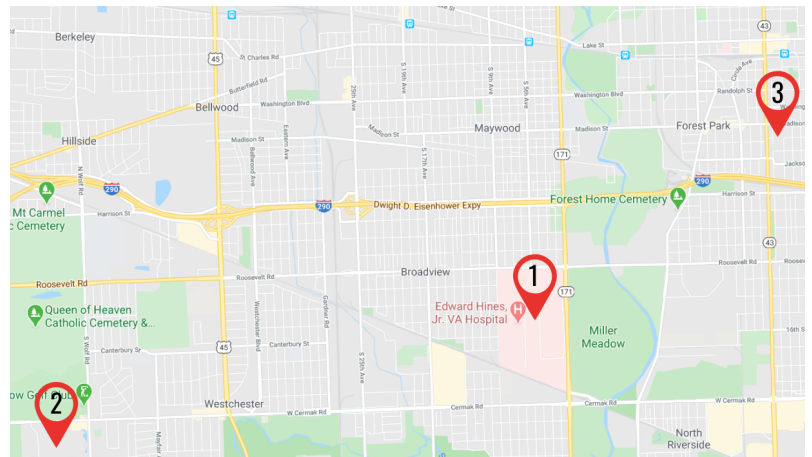
Will I need to pay for COVID-19 testing?

Medicare, Medicaid, government plans, and most private insurance plans will cover COVID-19 testing. However, double check with the testing site that they will accept your insurance to avoid out-of-network fees.
